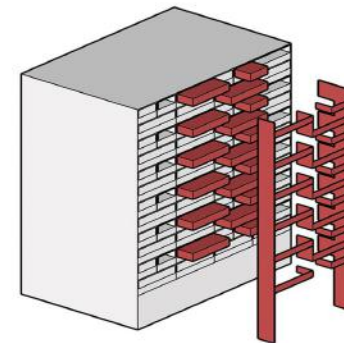

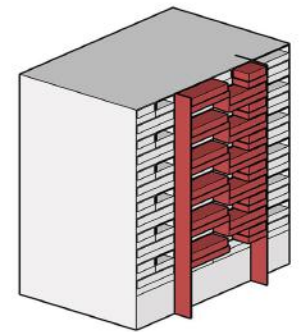

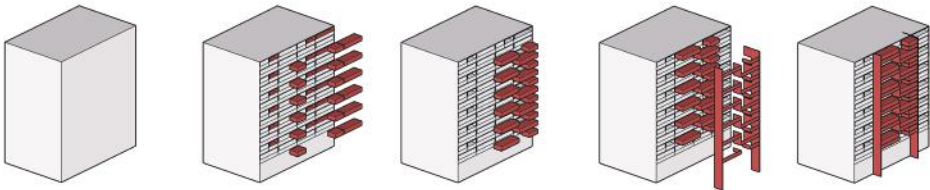
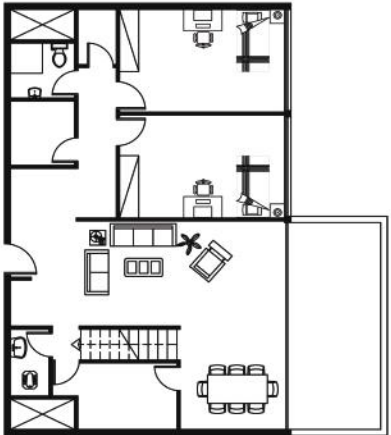
EKBATAN

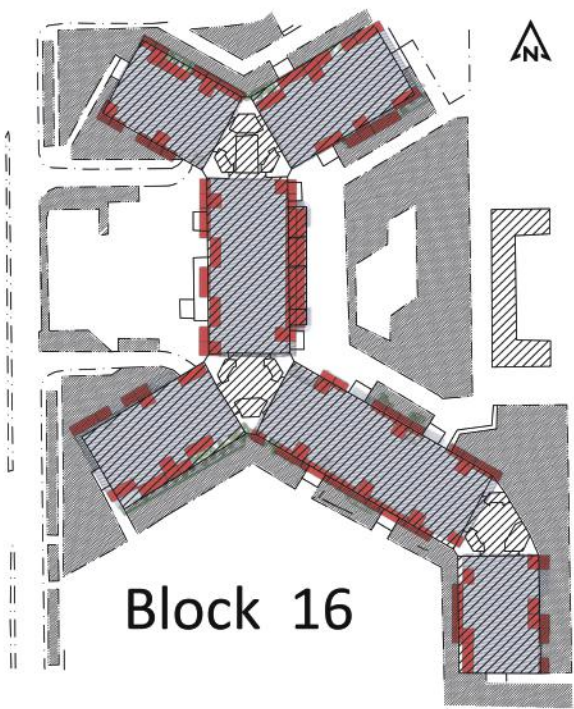
